

THEATER AND DANCE TALENT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FOR 2005

About the Scholarship

A talent scholarship is awarded annually to an upcoming first-year student who plans to major in one of the several disciplines taught in the Department of Theatre and Dance: acting and directing, design and technical theatre, or dance. This scholarship is entirely talent-based, carries an award of \$3000 per year, and is automatically renewable for a total of up to four years, provided the holder remains in the major and maintains a 2.50 GPA.

Application Procedures

If you are applying as a theatrical director, send a video of your work with the application form. If you are applying as a theatrical designer, send a slide portfolio with your application. Mail your completed application to:

Auditions and Interviews

We prefer to have all scholarship candidates present their work in person, in either an interview alone (directors, designers or technicians) or in an interview and audition (actors and dancers). However, actors and dancers who cannot come to Keene may send videotape showing two contrasting audition pieces. Please do not, under any circumstances, send the only existing copy of your work. Auditions should total no more than five minutes. If your audition requires music (either for dancing or singing), it should be on either a compact disc or a cassette tape; a player for these will be provided at the audition. For more detailed audition guidelines and recommendations, please call or email.

This year's audition date is **TBA**. Each interview or interview and audition should run approximately twenty minutes. If, due to serious schedule conflicts, you have a particular time preference, please let us know as soon as possible, and we will try to accommodate you.
